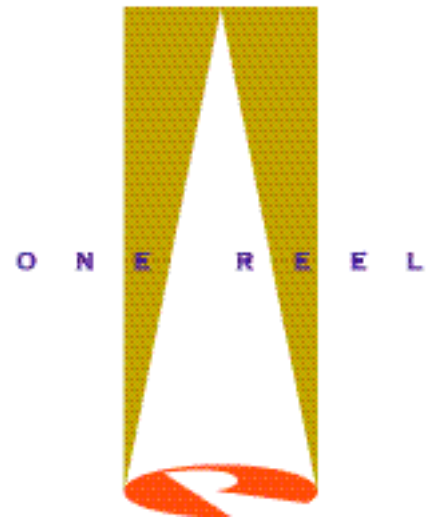

SUMMER NIGHTS CONCERT SERIES SET TO RETURN IN 2006 & BEYOND

SEATTLE, WA: One Reel is excited to announce the relocation of **the Summer Nights concert series** to **Gas Works Park** on Lake Union in Seattle for the summer of 2006 and beyond. The series will celebrate its 16th year at a new home beginning next June, with a line-up yet to be released. The new site promises all of the ambience and natural beauty of both prior locations – Pier 62/63 on the downtown Waterfront from 1991 to 2004, and South Lake Union Park last summer.

Audiences will once again be treated to one of Seattle's favorite summertime events, featuring intimate concerts with the highest production values in sound and light, as well as beautiful views of the water and boats in Lake Union and breathtaking sunsets over the downtown Seattle skyline. Venue capacity will remain at 3,800 and the series will again showcase the best in pop, R&B, blues, jazz and country.

Working closely with Seattle Parks and Recreation, One Reel began searching for a new venue for Summer Nights in 2004 when it was announced that Pier 62/63 needed to undergo structural improvements. A temporary location at South Lake Union Park was home to the 2005 series, but city plans to continue development of the park will prohibit another summer of concerts there. Summer Nights will remain at Gas Works Park until the series can be moved back to the central waterfront area once renovations are complete.

Gas Works Park is located at 2101 N. Northlake Way, on the north end of Lake Union. Improvements on the park are underway to ensure that next year's Summer Nights concerts are as spectacular as in years past without negatively impacting the surrounding neighborhood. Sound quality, views, parking and accessibility will all be optimal by the start of the series in June 2006.

The Summer Nights concert series is a production of One Reel, a Northwest non-profit arts and special events organization. One Reel also produces Bumbershoot- Seattle's Music & Arts Festival, The WAMU Family Fourth at Lake Union and Teatro ZinZanni-Seattle & San Francisco.
